A great singer died on August 16, 1977, radio and television programs all over the world were interrupted to give the news of his death. His name was Elvis Presley. President Carter, who was the President of the United States at that time, said to the nation, "Elvis Presley changed the face of American popular culture. He was unique and irreplaceable." Eighty thousand people attended his funeral and the streets were full (1) people and cars. His movies were (2) on television, and his records were played on the radio all day.

Elvis Presley was born in Mississippi on January 8, 1935. His twin brother died at birth. His parents were very poor and Elvis ( 3 ) had music lessons, but he was surrounded by music from an early age. His parents were very religious, and Elvis always sang at church.

After he left school in 1953, he got a job as a truck driver. In the summer of that year, he paid four dollars and recorded two songs for his mother's birthday. It was the beginning of his life as a musician. His popularity spread gradually throughout the world. Most of the songs he recorded were big (4). People called him "King of rock'n' roll."

In 1958, Elvis had to join the army. When his hair was cut, thousands of women cried because his hairstyle was one of his symbols. He spent the next two years in Germany, and there, he met a woman who became his wife eight years later.

After leaving the army, he went to Hollywood and he made several movies. Also when he went to Las Vegas and sang there, he was ( 5 ) 750,000 dollars in just four weeks. He had been working hard, eating and drinking ( 6 ) much for several years until a heart attack hit him. His only daughter was only nine years old when he died and left a large amount of his fortune to her.

Keita is in the second year of junior high school. He loves living things such as animals, insects, fish, birds and so on. He has three beetles and five goldfish now. Keita's sister Yuka also likes animals and has a dog and a cat. Keita's parents think that it's good for them to keep living things as pets. Because they can learn the importance of the life and the difficulty of taking care of them.

When Keita visited his grandfather in Aichi during summer vacation two years ago, he got up so early and he caught two beetles. At summer festival, he tried goldfish scooping, too, but he could scoop no fish. His grandfather was very good at it and he showed Keita how to scoop goldfish. His grandfather gave him some goldfish he caught there. So the beetles and the goldfish have been good pets since then. This summer Keita tried goldfish scooping again, and finally he could scoop up two goldfish.

Cleaning the aquarium and changing the water is Keita's job and he does it twice a month. At first, he moved the goldfish to a large bucket and he changed all water. At that time he used a little thick hose. It took 15 minutes to fill the empty aquarium with 45 liters of water. The amount of 45 liters is the best for his goldfish. But a few months later, he got to know one third of the old water should have been left in the aquarium. By doing so, he can maintain a good habitat, for example, keeping bacteria and no stress for goldfish. So since then, he has changed only two thirds of the old water. Of course he doesn't need to move goldfish. He just uses a sponge for cleaning the aquarium and scrub the inside it gently. There is no problem with dirty water as it will become cleaner after he changes the water. And then he puts water into the cleaned aquarium with a thinner hose. It causes little damage to the goldfish, though it takes long time, 45 minutes to fill the same empty aquarium with of water.

It's Sunday, just the day to clean the aquarium of goldfish today. He left one third of the old water as usual. At that time, Keita got a call from his friend Kaito and he promised to play tennis in the park at 11 o'clock. He has to finish cleaning the aquarium in a hurry because there are only 30 minutes left until the promised time. So he decided to use both the thick hose and the thin hose. Keita is about to start changing water hoping that nothing will happen to his goldfish.
